- Explore the development of Te rere of Te Wai system of learning

- Support the building of traditional waka and reclamation of navigational practices
- Support the revitalisation of Te reo o Whanganui including facilitating a wānanga reo

E TUPU I TŌU WHAKATUPURANGA
